Final installment of fairgrounds grant announced

The final installment of a \$450,000 state grant has been awarded for improvements at the Fayette County Fairgrounds, state Rep. Peter J. Daley II, D-Fayette/Washington, has announced.

"The grant is paying for the new roof over the Chevron Outdoor Arena," Mr. Daley said. "It's also helped to pay for the construction of a facility allowing reporters and announcers to safely view and report events."

The final \$50,000 has been awarded to the Fayette County Redevelopment Authority for the improvements, he said. The money is from the state's Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program, administered by the governor's Office of the Budget for the acquisition and construction of regional economic, cultural, civic and historical improvement projects, he said.
