

**COMBINED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM NOTICES FOR THE
INITIAL PUBLIC HEARING OF THE FY2017 PROGRAM AND
FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT MODIFICATION OF THE FY2016 PROGRAM
GERMAN TOWNSHIP – FAYETTE COUNTY, PA**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at the German Township Offices (2 Long St, Edenborn - McClellandtown, PA 15458) on February 13, 2018 at 5:45pm. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed.

The hearing will include a discussion of the Township's past and future use of CDBG funds, and address a proposed modification to the Township's FY2016 funded activities. CDBG funds are provided to the Township from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The Township's FY2017 CDBG allocation is anticipated to be approximately \$90,914. It is the stated policy of the County and the Township to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the County and/or Township to provide relocation assistance.
