

**NOTICE OF FINAL PUBLIC HEARING
SCOTSDALE BOROUGH – WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
PROPOSED USE OF FY2017 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs in Scottdale Borough and the proposed use of FY2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds will be held at the Scottdale Borough Offices (10 Mount Pleasant Road, Scottdale, PA) on Thursday, October 19, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed.

Scottdale Borough anticipates receiving a total FY2017 CDBG allocation of \$85,190 from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, which is proposed to be used for demolition, recreation improvements, and accessibility improvements / removal of architectural barriers. Seventy percent (70%) of available project funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The proposed activities will not result in any residential displacement.
