

**NOTICE OF INITIAL PUBLIC HEARING  
FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
FY2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at the Fayette County Redevelopment Authority (86 West Main Street, Uniontown, PA) on Monday, July 16, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed with advance notice.

The hearing will include a discussion of the County's past and future uses of CDBG funds in nonentitlement communities. CDBG funds are provided to the County from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The County's FY2018 CDBG allocation for use in nonentitlement communities is anticipated to be approximately \$265,767. It is the stated policy of the County to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the County and / or local municipality to provide relocation assistance.
