

**COMBINED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAMS:
GRANT MODIFICATION OF THE FY2015 PROGRAM AND
INITIAL PUBLIC HEARING OF THE FY2018 PROGRAM
SOUTH UNION TOWNSHIP - FAYETTE COUNTY, PA**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at South Union Township Offices (151 Township Drive - Uniontown, PA 15401) on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at 3:45pm. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed with advance notice.

The hearing will include a discussion of the Township's past and future use of CDBG funds, and address a proposed modification to the Township's FY2015 funded activities. CDBG funds are provided to the County from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The Township's FY2018 CDBG allocation is anticipated to be approximately \$149,144. It is the stated policy of the County and the Township to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the County and/or Township to provide relocation assistance.
