

**NOTICE OF INITIAL PUBLIC HEARING  
SCOTSDALE BOROUGH – WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
FY2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at the Scottdale Borough Offices (10 Mount Pleasant Road, Scottdale, PA) on Monday, September 10, 2018 at 6:15pm. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed with advance notice.

The hearing will include a discussion of the Borough's past and future use of CDBG funds. CDBG funds are provided to the Borough from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities which primarily benefit low and moderate income persons. Seventy percent (70%) of available project funds must benefit low and moderate income persons. The Borough's FY 2018 CDBG allocation is anticipated to be approximately \$92,171. It is the stated policy of the Borough to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the Borough to provide relocation assistance.
