

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT MODIFICATION
OF BULLSKIN TOWNSHIP
FY2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Fayette, Pennsylvania Offices (86 West Main Street – Uniontown, PA 15401) on Friday, February 3, 2017 at 10:00am. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities.

The hearing will address a proposed modification to the Township's FY2012 funded activities, and may include discussion of other Township past and future uses of CDBG funds. CDBG funds are provided to the Township from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities which primarily benefit low and moderate income persons. It is the stated policy of the Township to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the Township to provide relocation assistance.
