Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held at the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Fayette, Pennsylvania Offices (86 West Main Street – Uniontown PA, 15401) on March 21, 2019 at 9:00am. This location is accessible to persons with disabilities. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including LEP persons, as needed with advance notice.

The hearing will address several proposed modifications to the County's FY2014-2017 funded activities. More specifically, the modification involves shifting funds from cancelled or completed road reconstruction projects to both new and previously approved activities. Projects proposed are located along Ohler Road in Bullskin Township, and in the Filbert-Fairbank and Cardale Areas of Redstone Township. The hearing may include a discussion of other County past and future uses of CDBG funds. CDBG funds are provided to the Township from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low- and moderate-income persons. It is the stated policy of the County to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the County to provide relocation assistance.
