

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT MODIFICATIONS
OF FAYETTE COUNTY, PA AND OBO
BULLSKIN, GEORGES, AND NORTH UNION TOWNSHIPS
FY2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing to obtain the views and comments of citizens on community development needs will be held on **November 20, 2020** at 9:30am at the Fayette County Redevelopment Authority (86 West Main Street, Uniontown, PA 15401). Due to the COVID-19 crisis, this meeting will be held online at: <https://join.freeconferencecall.com/racf>. Every effort will be made to provide the needed materials to all residents, including persons with disabilities and LEP persons, upon request. Please call 724-437-1547 ext. 210 at least 72 hours in advance of the hearing to request technical assistance.

The hearing will address proposed modifications to the County's FY2018 funded activities for three (3) of the County's Entitlement Townships: Bullskin, Georges, and North Union. Proposed modifications will reallocate the balances of completed projects to other previously approved activities to complete funding as follows:

- Bullskin Township – Move funding from the balance of a completed road reconstruction project along Sherrick Road to another previously approved road reconstruction project along Wiltrout Hollow Road to complete funding.
- Georges Township - Move the remaining funding balance of a completed road reconstruction project along Township Drive to another previously approved road reconstruction project in the Club York Area to complete funding.
- North Union Township - Move the remaining funding balance of a completed road reconstruction project in the Youngstown Area to another previously approved road reconstruction in the Lemont Furnace II Area to complete funding.

The hearing may include discussion of other past and future uses of CDBG funds. CDBG funds are provided to the county and its entitlement townships from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low- and moderate-income persons. These proposed activities plan for no displacement of any persons or affordable housing units. It is the stated policy of the County and its Entitlement Townships to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the County and / or Township to provide relocation assistance.

All interested agencies, groups and persons wishing to comment on the proposed modifications or any of the County's community development needs and use of CDBG funds may submit written remarks to the attention of Andrew French, Executive Director at the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Fayette, PA (86 West Main Street, Uniontown PA 15401) by the end of day, **November 23, 2020**. At this time, electronic comments are preferred. Emails may be sent to bgirod@racfpa.org. Please indicate which municipalities and activities you are addressing.

Each municipality will consider approval of the proposed modifications at their next regular meeting. The County Commissioners will consider final approval at their December meeting.
