The hearing will address the proposed request for funding through the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Competitive Program. If approved, funds will be used for a proposed sanitary sewer system improvement project in the West Leisenring Area of the Township.

The hearing may include discussion of other past and future uses of CDBG funds. CDBG funds are provided to the county and its entitlement townships from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) and may be utilized for a variety of community development and housing activities. Seventy percent (70%) of available funds must benefit low- and moderate-income persons. The proposed project plans for no displacement of any persons or affordable housing units. It is the stated policy of the County and its Entitlement Townships to avoid activities which result in displacement. In the unlikely event any activity funded by the CDBG program results in displacement, it is the responsibility of the Township to provide relocation assistance.

It is anticipated that Dunbar Township will consider approval of the proposed application at its next regular meeting on **September 3, 2020** at 7:00pm. The County Commissioners will consider final approval at an upcoming public meeting, prior to the grant submission deadline in February 2021.
